Tournament Rules

1. TDA rules will be used for this event.
2. All levels will be 50 minutes in duration; players will start with \$6000 in chips.
3. Dinner break will be at 6:30 PM, and will last for 1 hour.
4. Play will continue to the final table or 2AM, whichever comes first. If more than one table remains, play will resume at 2PM the following day. If only the final table remains, play will resume at 4PM the following day.
5. 3% will be withheld from the total prize pool for tournament dealers and staff.
6. \$5,150 will be withheld from the prize pool to award the winner of the tournament an entry into the World Poker Open Championship Event #136. This event begins on Sunday August 9, and concludes on Tuesday, August 11.
7. Seats to the World Poker Open Championship Event #36 are non-transferable.
8. All prior seat winners will be paid with 10 (ten) \$500 Buy-in Chips and \$150 in cash.

The Mississippi Gaming Commission reserves the right to investigate any and all complaints and disputes regarding tournament, promotions and drawings. Such disputes and complaints will be resolved in accordance with the Mississippi Gaming Control Act and Mississippi Gaming Commission.
