Tournament Rules

1. TDA rules will be used for this event.
2. All levels will be 70 minutes in duration.
3. There will be a break every two levels and will last 15 minutes.
4. There will be a 1 hour dinner break at 6:30 PM each day.
5. Players will start with \$20,000 in chips.
6. If the event has 250 players or more, 9 levels will be played on day one, otherwise 8 levels will be played on day one.
7. Day 2 will begin play at 12PM in Ballroom A, B & C and continue until 9 players remain.
8. Day 3 will start in Ballroom A, B or C at 2PM.
9. 3% will be withheld from total prize pool for tournament dealers and staff.
10. \$10,000 will be withheld from the prize pool to award the winner an entry into the Southern Poker Championship WPT Main Event. This event will be hosted by Beau Rivage in January 2010.
11. Seat to the Southern Poker Championship WPT Main Event is non-transferable.
